

CARE AND USE INSTRUCTIONS

MAINTENANCE:

All Memphis Steel and Iron Works doors are constructed of steel with a high quality, multi-part paint finish. If the paint finish is scratched or damaged in any way, especially if raw steel is exposed, it should be immediately touched up to prevent rust. Follow the instruction video located at www.msiworks.com in order to complete this process. If in a salt water and/ or air environment the door should be cleaned regularly following the instructions below in order to prevent salt build up. Left unattended salt build up can damage the finish and eventually rust could appear.

RUST:

The doors are not warranted against rust if the above maintenance procedures are not followed. If rust is present it should be completely removed with sandpaper and using the touch up process as mentioned previously.

CLEANING THE DOOR:

Cleaning of the door is best performed by dusting of the door using a clean soft cloth. If required, a very mild soap and water solution can be used. Never use an abrasive detergent or a solvent based product of any kind as these will damage the finish. If in a salt water and/or air environment the exterior of the door should be cleaned regularly with water or mild soap and water to remove any salt buildup. If soap and water is used always be sure to rinse with clean water. Use of a high-volume water spray is not recommended.
